Have you ever wanted to learn to make pottery on the wheel? If so this is the class for you. This course will provide students with the knowledge necessary to learn the basics of throwing pottery. At the end of the course, students may elect to re-take the class or advance to the next levels of throwing – “Next Step Wheel Throwing” or Wheel Throwing 102. Completion of this course also allows eligibility for Open Studio Membership

This is an ADULT CLASS

Some of the skills that will be taught:

- Learning to center clay on the wheel
- Learning to throw cylinders
- Learning about trimming and glazing

Requirements:

- Registration fee covers instruction and and operational costs.
- Students must have their own pottery tools (Tool kits are available at the Art Center for \$15).
- Minimum number of students: 3
- Maximum number of students: 6
