## Next Step Throwing: Building on the Basics

This 6-week class is designed specifically to meet the needs of the person who knows basic throwing techniques, but wants to advance their throwing skills.

### Some of the skills that will be taught:

- Knowledge of basic pottery terms
- Forming a cylinder into a shape
- Creative decorative designs on the clay surface
- Creating and attaching handles
- Throwing and fitting a lid
- Shaping a spout for a pitcher

### Requirements:

- **Not for Beginners** - Students must have knowledge of basic throwing and be able to center the clay and pull a small cylinder.
- Registration fee covers instruction and operational costs.
- Students must have their own pottery tools (Tool kits are available at the Art Center for \$15).
- Minimum number of students: 3
- Maximum number of students: 6
